Activating Clocks on the inCloud Portal

To easily activate your clocks on the inCloud Management portal, download American Time's Network Clocks mobile app for Android devices (see QR code provided below).



Scan the QR code to the left to download the Network Clocks mobile app. The app allows you to quickly and easily set up clocks on inCloud. Scan the QR code to the right to access the quickstart guide for the Network Clocks mobile app.





If clocks can only be activated using a computer, follow the steps listed below.

- 1. Navigate to the inCloud portal: <u>incloud.american-time.com</u>. Log in using the credentials supplied in the welcome e-mail from American Time.
- 2. Click on the green "Setup New" button in the PoE Devices bar on the Devices List page. This will open the Activate Network Devices page, which will list all the clocks assigned to your site by American Time.
- 3. Click the MAC address.
 - If you have multiple devices to set up, the MAC address can be searched using the last five characters of the address including the colon (for example, AA:11) in the search bar.
- 4. Reference the MAC Address Log Sheet from Step 5 for the installation location and enter the location in the Device Title field.

If you have additional clocks to set up, repeat Steps 3 and 4 until your setup is complete. Once you have finished setting up clocks, clicking on "Devices" in the sidebar menu will take you back to the Devices List page.

After activation, clocks will appear as partially activated in the Devices List until they communicate with inCloud fully; this may take up to one hour, but clocks will function normally until that occurs.

Set up the Clock


- 1. Apply power to the clocks by connecting Cat 5 or higher Ethernet cables (A) from a PoE switch (Fig. 1) to the PoE receivers (D). The cables should have already been run through the double-dial mounting ring duing the installation of the ring.
 - PoE Switch Check with network administrator for infrastructure needs. This part is not supplied by American Time.
- 2. The status LED (B) will indicate the clocks' statuses as follows:
 - · Flashing Red: Acquiring an IP address using DHCP
 - Continuous Red: Acquired IP address
 - Flashing Orange: Attempting SNTP sync
 - Continuous Green: Successful SNTP sync

Following the IP connection and SNTP sync, inCloud-connected clocks will communicate with the management portal. During this communication period, the LED will flash green.

3. The buzzer LED (C) designates if the buzzer is enabled. The buzzer is an optional feature.

Note: When a DHCP network is not present at initial start up, the PoE clocks will default to a random Static IP in the range of 169.254.1.0 to 169.254.255.


A=PoE connection (Cat 5 or higher Ethernet patch cable)

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Hang your clocks

- Before mounting the clocks, find the MAC address for the clocks on the included MAC address log sheet and note the location of the clocks (i.e. room number) for future reference. The clock MAC address is located on the back of each clock.
- 2. Place the hanger on the back of the clocks on the screws protruding from the top lug on the double-dial ring as shown below. Wall-mount installation is pictured; for ceiling-mount clocks, the mounting ring will be rotated 90 degrees and the protruding screws will be in the lug nearest the mounting ring base.
- 3. Tighten the screws on the edge of the double-dial ring to secure the clocks in place as shown below.
